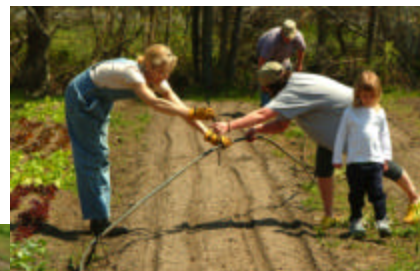


Medora loved organic farming.

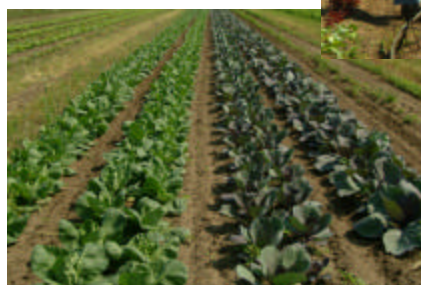
The Medora Harvest Fund is part of a non-profit organization founded by Provident Organic Farm, a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) farm. The fund was started by CSA members and the family of Medora Cockey, after her untimely death in January 2004.

Medora Cockey was a young woman whose life was tragically cut short by a sudden illness, just after she finished college. She spent her summers working on organic farms. Medora had a passionate faith in the ideals of organic farming: safe food, the use of renewable resources, respect for the environment, and involvement in the growing process. The fund honors Medora's commitment by providing healthy food to our neighbors in need.

Provident Organic Farm is owned by Jay Martin, a dedicated organic farmer with over 20 years of experience. Jay runs the farm with the help of a large group of CSA member volunteers. In the CSA system, the local consumer partners with



the farmer before the season starts and becomes a member by purchasing a share of the upcoming season's harvest. Each week during the season, members receive weekly allotments containing a wide variety of fresh, organic produce.

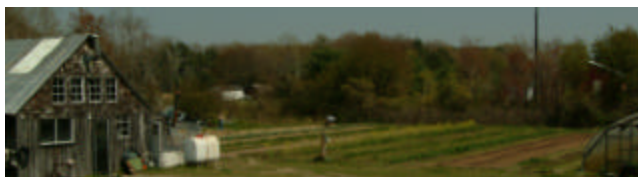
